10.	Bachelor's Degree	The completed bachelor's degree requirement is waived for CMU AMP applicants.			

Benefits of the AMP for CMU Undergraduates:

- You will complete two semesters of coursework as an integrated undergraduate-graduate student before graduating with a Bachelor's degree in May of your senior year
- You will be able to complete an internship in the summer following your senior year
- Completing your internship prior to starting the final two semesters will allow you to have more work experience to discuss with recruiters visiting campus during the fall semester
- You will be eligible for MISM-BIDA financial aid in the final two semesters of the program (after having **completed** a Bachelor's degree)
- You may be able to exempt certain Heinz courses with units earned via undergraduate coursework which would give you more flexibility in course selection. The undergraduate courses that qualify to exempt a Heinz course are reviewed each academic year.

- * Up to 36 units of relevant undergraduate classes completed while enrolled in the MISM-BIDA program may be transferred and counted toward the required 162 units. Courses should be upper division and relevant to the content of the MISM-BIDA degree. A **grade of "B" or better** must be earned in order to count the units toward the MISM-BIDA degree. You should discuss this with the MISM program office. At least 126 MISM-BIDA units of coursework would remain to be completed.
- **Some MISM-BIDA coursework may fulfill undergraduate requirements. You should discuss this with your undergraduate advisor.
- ***Students must maintain a minimum of 36 units per semester in Year 2.

Financial Aid Information

Financial aid for senior year will continue as it has in prior years (undergraduate students do not qualify for Heinz/ MISM-BIDA financial aid in their senior year).

AMP Students <u>will</u> qualify for MISM-BIDA scholarships and graduate student financial aid in the final two semesters (year 5 at CMU) of the MISM-BIDA AMP (after having **completed** their Bachelor's degree).
