INSTALLING THE ANALYSIS TOOLPAK FOR EXCEL

- 1. If you do not have Microsoft Office installed, please install it before proceeding.
- 2. Open Excel.
- 3. If you have Windows:
 - a. Click File tab, click Options, and then click the Add-ins category.
 - b. In the Manage box, select Excel add-ins, then click Go.
 - c. In the Add-ins box, check the Analysis ToolPak checkbox then click OK.
 - i. If the Analysis ToolPak is not listed, in the Add-ins available box, click Browse to locate it.
- 4. If you have Mac OS X:
 - a. Click the **Tools** menu, then click **Excel Add-ins**.
 - b. In the Add-ins available box, select the Analysis ToolPak checkbox, then click OK.
 - i. If **Analysis ToolPak** is not listed in the **Add-Ins available** box, click **Browse** to locate it.
- 5. Quit Excel and reopen. Data Analysis is available on the Data tab.
